NoteWorthy Instruction Program – Metro Area Schools

Since 1989, MacPhail School Partnerships have been enriching the lives of students by providing unrivaled in-person or live online instruction in tandem with Minnesota schools. Our staff works with schools to develop customized and relevant programming through individual instruction, sectionals, ELL support, residencies, masterclasses, and more.

Project Amplify is an equity-focused music education initiative offered to Minnesota K-12 music classrooms at no charge to the school. The program focuses on strengthening learning opportunities for K-12 Minnesota music students from historically underrepresented backgrounds by providing transformational programming that nurtures creativity, honors students' backgrounds, and provides tools and resources to support K-12 educators. These efforts are made possible with the generous support of donors.

Through Project Amplify, we are excited to announce the third year of our **NoteWorthy Instruction Program**. This opportunity will grant ten Twin Cities metro area schools 25 hours' worth of in-person instruction from MacPhail faculty to supplement their music classroom. Project examples include sectional coaching, music production courses, composition residencies, etc.

Chosen proposals will be announced by May 30, 2025 via email, and we will set up a time to discuss scheduling and logistics. If selected for the Noteworthy Instruction Program, some small changes may be necessary to meet both your goals and logistical needs. However, you will work directly with the School Partnerships team to help your vision come to life. We may request media releases to help us document the project on our website.
